POSTER SESSIONS: Students enrolled in post secondary education programs in counseling, social work, and other related fields are encouraged to apply for poster session slots which offer opportunity for presenters to summarize their information and share it with conference participants in a less formal manner.

At this conference, each poster session presenter will have the opportunity to display a poster that provides a general description or overview of their topic/research. Since information exchange and networking are very beneficial for participants, the poster sessions will provide additional opportunities to develop new relationships with colleagues and learn what research or knowledge that is being currently disseminated.

Poster session topics, descriptions, and presenters' names will be included in the conference folder.

1. When planning your poster presentation, remember that the poster will be available for viewing and discussion for only a limited period of time. Posters should be readable from five feet away and should be understandable without oral explanation. Handouts and related program materials are encouraged.
2. Aim for clarity and simplicity when designing your poster. Please include the presentation title as well as presenter names. Include the highlights of your presentation, including the goals of any services described and strategies for meeting the needs of students who are deaf and hard of hearing.
3. We will provide an easel and a table to display your poster and materials. You will be able to secure your poster to a piece of foam core board that will be attached to the easel. Push pins and tape will be provided. The foam core board will be 32" by 40" and your poster should not exceed that size.
4. The poster sessions will be held on Saturday, April 14, 2012 for a period not lasting more than 2 hours depending on the number of submissions. No other sessions will be scheduled for this time period. As of this time, we are planning to have the entire poster session in one large room and this should allow all participants to meet with presenters for group and individual discussions. A setup time will be allotted to allow all presenters ample time to prepare.

Deadline for Submitting Poster Proposal is February 28, 2011.

Program/Poster Abstract

Please develop a brief description (not to exceed 125 words) of the proposed presentation. This will be included in the conference program package.

Please submit a summary (not to exceed 500 words) of the proposed presentation for consideration by the planning committee.
